## In 2017 34 % of Taxes and Utility Bills were not paid

Every year over \$200,000 of operating funds ear-marked for budget items towards basic city services and projects cannot be spent due to delinquent taxes and utility payments. All tax payers suffer when services are delayed or cancelled.

**In July 2018**, the City will be shutting off water in Greenwood, Anaconda and the North-End to property owners that do not pay their utility bills.
