Update 2021

Due to Covid-19 normal operation closed March 17, 2020, but continued to offer services online  
Re-opened mid-August with restrictions, two people at a time  
Collaborate with other groups, Reading Link Challenge, joint children's group  
Fines eliminated January 2020  
Board voted to increase library staffed open hours  
Further increase hours in spring with volunteers  
Computer access offered again  
Public welcome to use library's wifi signal whether library open or not  
Community Futures uses space in library one day a week  
Library is the only local provider of photocopying, faxing & scanning.  
Request that the City substantially increase grant-in-aid for 2021 and beyond  
Donations & fundraisers have increased through community support  
Ongoing problem of insufficient operating funds continues  
Local governments to be primary funding sources for local public libraries  
Physical barriers: not wheel-chair accessible, heavy door to open  
need automatic door opener

 Campground Update -  
 Discussion

**Signage:** “Campground” needs to be a large font size instead of “Greenwood”  
 Add motorhome to sign??  
 Lighting under roof. Another sign placed at Nikkei Park.

**Firepits:** Need to be durable: Stone or Steel  
 Not easily removed from campground  
 Complies with fire regulations/restraints  
 Steel price going up \$550 to \$750,  
 Camping Fees: \$40-\$45 serviced site  
 \$10 - \$20 tent site; adjust for long weekends.  
 On-line reservations  
 No bathroom or shower facilities – dependent upon grants.  
 Looking at May for start date

**Picnic Tables:** Wood tables will require annual  
 maintenance: staining (\$650 – 750)  
 Composite tables may be hot to touch  
 requires zero maintenance, (\$1200)  
 Need 20 tables: (\$13,000 – 23,000)  
 Wheelchair access tables, tip-proof  
 Six tent sites; 10 serviced sites

 Entry Signage - Discussion

Existing locations near Greenwood School and Anaconda Townsite

Carriage Homes - Discussion

Consider tiny homes on foundation. Stick-built or fabricated not on wheels. Smaller lots need to be addressed.
