

# Outdoor Water Use Restrictions STAGE 1

We encourage residents to keep neighbourhoods safe by managing anything that attracts bears and other wildlife around your home, including your household garbage.

- Securely store waste and recycling bins inside a shed, enclosure or garage.
- Only put your bins out the morning of pickup, not the night before.
- Remove other attractants such as bird feeders and pet food.


#### <u>Summer Property Maintenance</u>

The City of Greenwood Bylaw No. 928, 2018 **PROHIBITS ALL** Residents from:

- Allowing Grass to exceed 6 (six) inches in height on property and boulevards.
- Allowing the accumulation of dead landscaping to remain on property.
- Allowing shrubs, hedges or trees to grow over sidewalks, or be untrimmed.
- Permitting tree branches or hedges to overhang sidewalks or fire hydrants.
