

Business license renewal fees for 2025 are now overdue. Businesses without a valid license will be deemed inactive and canceled.

If there have been changes to your business status or if you need assistance, please contact or visit City Hall.

Property Tax Notices Coming in May

Property tax notices will be mailed in May, and payments are due by July 02, 2025. If you are paying by e-transfer or online, please ensure your payment is received at least three days before the deadline to avoid penalties of 2.5%.

Don't forget to apply for your Homeowner's Grant annually, either online or by phone.

2025 Second Quarter Utility Bills

The 2025 second quarter utility bills are **due June 30, 2025**. To avoid a **2.5% penalty for late payments**, please ensure your payment is submitted on time.

Payment Options:

- 1. Mail: Send your payment to City Hall.
- 2. **Drop Box:** Use the secure drop box on City Hall's front steps.
- 3. **Electronic Funds Transfer (EFT):** Through your financial institution (allow 3 business days for processing).
- 4. E-Transfer: Send to finance.greenwoodcity@shaw.ca.
 - Include your account number in the memo section to ensure proper processing.

Protect Our Pipes: No Wipes or Paper Towels!

Residents, please remember—**only toilet paper should be flushed!** Paper towels, wipes (even "flushable" ones), and other materials do not break down like toilet paper and can clog pipes, leading to costly plumbing repairs and sewer backups. Help keep our sewer system running smoothly by disposing of these items in the trash.

Thank you for doing your part to protect our community's water system!

Street Sweeping Coming in April!

The City of Greenwood will be conducting street sweeping during the 1st and 2nd week of April, weather permitting. This service helps keep our streets clean by removing debris, improving drainage, and reducing pollutants from entering our waterways.

Street Sweeper Safety Tips

When you see a street sweeper in your neighborhood, keep these safety tips in mind:

- ☑ **Give Them Space** Stay at least 50 feet behind the sweeper to avoid dust and debris.
- ✓ **Drive Cautiously** Be patient and avoid passing the sweeper unless it is safe to do so.
- ▼ Keep Kids & Pets Safe Stay on sidewalks and away from moving sweepers.
- ✓ Move Vehicles Off the Street If possible, park in driveways or garages to allow a thorough clean of the streets.

Hydrant Flushing Scheduled for April

Pulic Works will be conducting hydrant flushing throughout the City this April. This routine maintenance helps ensure our hydrants are in good working order and maintains water quality.

During this time, residents may experience temporary fluctuations in water pressure. However, no other impacts to water service are expected.
