

#### Get Your Home Ready for Winter

Winter is just around the corner and we all know it can be hard on our homes. When the temperature drops, the heat goes on-and that calls for extra precautions. Here are some tips to help you reduce and prevent unexpected issues this winter season.

#### Outside:

- Clean the eavestroughs and windows wells of debris.
- Look for cracks in the foundation and, if necessary, have them sealed by a professional.
- Prune tree branches that are likely to break under the weight of snow or freezing rain.
- Turn off outside water taps.

#### Inside:

- Have your chimney cleaned regularly and install a fireplace screen to stop sparks from reaching the surrounding floor coverings.
- Install smoke and carbon monoxide detectors on every floor of your home.
- Make sure your heating appliances are in good condition (furnace, fireplace, wood burning stove and other heat sources).
- Never leave burning candles unattended. Blow them out before leaving the room.
